Aim:	To provide coaches with the capacity to assist the performance riders to train to compete to the highest level in national <u>and/or</u> international competitions

Duration of the course (contact days):	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 8 days (“Pilot” course only 5 days)
Entry Requirements for Participants:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No minimum age limit • FEI Level 2 course Certificate of Achievement (or equivalent certification) • Positive evaluation from the Tutor responsible during the FEI Level 2 course • Recommendation by NF responsible

Procedure of attendance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The FEI Tutor has the final decision on the selection of candidates
Coach Profile:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To work as a Level 3 “specialist” coach for Eventing • To prepare national Individuals for national and regional international 3*** CCIs/CICs • To prepare Teams <u>and/or</u> Individuals for P/J/YR/S Regional/Continental Championships
Insurance:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participants must be registered with their NF coach insurance scheme or privately
Assessment: Except for the “Pilot” Course where there will be only an evaluation of the candidates (pedagogical and technical) after the course	Assessment procedure during and after the course <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pre-course questionnaire • Open-book mid-course questionnaire • Practical coaching sessions during the course (the candidate will be observed throughout the course and this will be taken into account in the final assessment) • The season logbook, completion of 20 sessions after the course and submission to the FEI within 12 months • Preparation of a video • Written, Oral and Practical exam over two days, from 6 to 12 months after the course
